Purpose

History

The Minnesota Building Permit Technicians Association was established in 1997. In 2003, the Association became an official chapter of the International Code Council (ICC). Association members typically are employed in fields related to building code compliance. Members work in code administration, building permit issuance, building inspections and related governmental agencies.

Meetings

Association meetings are held six times a year at various locations. Meetings include a business meeting and an educational offering. The educational presenters are building officials, building inspectors, ICC representatives, state Construction Codes and Licensing staff, motivational speakers and others with relevant material.

Newsletters

MBPTA publishes a bi-monthly newsletter. The newsletter contains information on meeting dates, meeting locations, many educational opportunities and MBPTA-sponsored events, as well as other pertinent items and informational articles.

Committees

MBPTA has multiple working committees. Committees include the Education Committee, the Bylaws Committee, and the Communications Committee.
